#	Change
1	Render – now returns HTTP 429 "Too Many Requests" when queue limits are reached. Previously returned the general 400 "Bad Request".
2	New template functionality << refLookupOp:>> which allows simple optional data- driven inclusion of sub-templates. This field will quitely do nothing if the data reference is null/blank.
3	Array lookups can now use variables for more dynamic referencing options. Eg < <pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre><<pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre></pre>
4	The RenderAPI by default disables generation of PDF form fields (which is consistent with DWS2 and DWS3). A new parameter "pdfCreateForm" allows this to be set explicity to true or false.
5	Outbound requests from Docmosis (eg fetching images from URLS specified in data) can now supply a custom header, mostly for security identification purposes. Please contact Docmosis support if you would like an outbound header enabled on your account.
6	Template :sort, :filter, :group repeating functions now work specifically with data in the context of each item being repeated over. Previously Docmosis would attempt to automatically work with the parent data, but this is too ambiguous and can raise errors depending on specifics of the data. As an example, < <rs_people:sort(name)>> is explicitly sorting by the name of each object in the people array.</rs_people:sort(name)>

2	Notify users when overwriting templates (via upload or rename)

#	Change
1	Sample data generation understands repeating over groups (:group() operator) and doesn't generate incorrect sample data.
2	Sample data generation was failing for templates with a corner case error in an expression.
3	Fix to user console to allow a template with a # character in the name to be rendered.
4	Template names can now include the "long hyphen" character.
5	Some new fonts (that were present on DWS3) are now present on DWS4.

	/environment/summary - get details about an environment. This is the dws4 equivalent of the dws3 end point /accountReady
