Notes:

- The first two Yes/No dropdown feilds are “joined” together (ie they will both have the same value) because they are both called “Agrees_es_”
- The second Yes/No feild is called “Agrees2_es_”
- The font size of the Yes/No fields has been changed to font size 4. This is because the width of the field in AdobeSign is determined by the space between the { { and } } brackets.
- There is a blank line at the start of each table cell – so that the fields in the PDF don’t sit over the top of the border of the table cell.
