

Master Template

Templates can contain references to other templates.

<<ref:XXXX

The “**ref**” method requires the name of the subTemplate to be known in advance and it is included in the master template.

<<refLookup:YYYY

The “**refLookup**” method allows the name of the subTemplate to be passed in the data.

NOTE: In either case, the file name of the subTemplate should be relative to the location of the Master template.

The content following this line has been included from the file Sub1.doc. This subTemplate is in folder one level down from where the Master template is.

Sub Template 1

Any fields in the subTemplate will also be populated like so:

This piece of data is used in the first subTemplate

The content following this line has been included from the file that is named in the data by “subTemplateName”. In this example it is Sub2.doc.

Sub Template 2

Fields may also be used in the sub templates like so:

This piece of data is used in the second subTemplate

NOTE: Only the BODY of the sub templates will be used. The HEADER/FOOTER of the main template will persist in the final document.
